

## ALME Grant Overview

## **DESCRIPTION**

The Alliance Licensed Ministry Experience (ALME) Grant is to assist a church in hiring a prospective international worker (IW) for a position that will provide valuable ministry for the church and valuable experience for the potential IW. ALME is a requirement for prospective IWs before they are placed in a field.

## **GUIDELINES**

An ALME Grant will be awarded according to these guidelines:

- To churches that submit a detailed position description that demonstrates how the prospective IW will be developed in evangelism, discipleship and leadership while serving in the church and how the church will benefit from having an ALME candidate
- To churches that can make a two-year commitment to the prospective IW at least 20 hours per week (as defined by the Alliance guidelines for ALME service as found in the Alliance Missions Handbook)
- To churches that desire to be a sending church for the prospective IW and desires to partner with them in their future missions endeavor
- For a single year with a second-year contingent on the continued employment of the prospective IW, their adherence to the ALME guidelines, and the completion of the ALME Grant Evaluation Form within the next open grant window.
- This grant can be for up to \$10,000 a year.
- Based on the availability of approved ALME candidates
